Ferrari Full Circle Pool Service - Opening Information

Full Opening - Includes removal and folding of safety cover, lowering cover anchors. Reassembly of filter equipment, reinstallation of wall fittings, handrails and ladders, start up and operational check.

Partial Opening - Includes the same service above without cover removal. Pool cover must be removed prior to our arrival.

**Opening prices do not include repairs, chemicals, cleaning leaves, vacuuming, pumping or cleaning of solid cover.*

**Covers will be folded and left with closing items poolside to be stored in a safe place by customer.*

Additional Services Available

Opening Chemicals - Chemicals are necessary to sanitize your pool water and to adjust your basic water chemistry. We offer an *Opening Package* with BIOGUARD brand pool chemicals This package includes: Up To - 25lbs alkalinity, 12lbs calcium, 10lbs chlorine shock, 2lbs algae treatment, 1qt algaecide, 1qt Scale Inhibitor and Test Strips. Pools over 30,000 gallons may require larger chem package. Salt pools need to add salt in addition to balancing chemicals. Available salt products are Mineral Springs Beginnings by BIOGUARD or Basic Pool Salt. Please note: Ferrari Full Circle Pool Service does not guarantee that the Opening Chemical package alone will completely clear and balance your water. We recommend having your water tested and additional chemicals added if level need adjusted after the pool has had time to circulate. If your pool water does not clear within a couple days, your filter will most likely need be cleaned, and more chlorine shock added. Your pool filter should run 24 hours per day until water is clear. Pools should run a minimum of 10-12 hours per day after clear.

Season Chemical Delivery - Please select any season chemicals you want delivered on your Opening form.

Spring Cleaning - Spring Cleaning service is available on a first come first served basis for non-Valet contract customers. Cleanings are typically performed, schedule permitting, within a few days after notification from you, that your water is clear and you can see to the bottom of the deep end. Cleaning is charged at \$165.00 per hour, for each hour. Any additional time will be invoiced separately from pool opening if more than one hour is required. Customers with a signed Valet Service Contract will automatically be cleaned and invoiced for Spring Cleaning service as it is required to make pool usable. Although, we will try our best, we cannot guarantee your pool will be 100% clean with only one, one-hour service visit. It may take more than one visit and additional chemicals depending on severity. Due to heavy demand this service could be limited in May.

Valet Service - We offer weekly and biweekly vacuum and monthly filter cleaning in select local service areas. If you would like to contract for Valet Service, please complete and return the Valet Service Agreement which can be [downloaded here](#).

Service Repairs - Please list any known repairs you need on the Opening Agreement Form. Hourly Rate for repairs that can be performed during the time of your opening is \$165.00 per hour in addition to the Opening. If repairs cannot be performed for any reason during your opening a return trip will be required. Return trips will be charged the standard service call rate of \$165.00.

Please read the following instructions to be sure your Opening proceeds smoothly

Solid winter covers – Solid covers must be free of water and debris prior to our arrival. A minimum fee of \$160.00 plus any time needed to clear cover will be charged in addition to the cost of a full opening. Ferrari Full Circle Pool Service will not be responsible for washing covers or the cost of cleaning any debris or leaves that may fall into the pool while removing cover.

Water Level - Pool water needs to be filled up to the middle of the skimmer prior to our arrival. We do not add or lower water. If the level is not high enough, we will set up the pool for opening, customer will fill and start. If we need to return to start the system because of low water level a return charge will be incurred. Any chemicals ordered will be left pool side to be added after pool is running.

Access - We prefer that you be home, but it is not required. If you will not be home, please make sure of the following:

**Gate is left unlocked or entry instructions are given. (We will not jump fences).*

**Power and water are turned on to the pool area.*

**All supplies skimmer baskets, fittings, filter cartridges are left poolside.*

Pets - For their safety & ours, please confine all pets prior to our arrival.

Scheduling – Opening and closing dates are prescheduled based on previous year services. If the prescheduled date is not agreeable, please let us know and we will reschedule to a more suitable date. We will not open your pool unless we have received your signed agreement complete with payment prior to scheduled date. Openings are performed Mon-Fri anytime from 7 am until 5 pm. We do not give scheduled times of day for arrival. In case of bad weather or any unforeseen circumstances you will be notified and rescheduled to our earliest opportunity. Any rescheduled openings are usually completed by Saturday of the week scheduled.

After the Opening

Cleaning and chemical maintenance should start immediately. Chemical levels should be checked weekly for proper pH, alkalinity, and calcium and adjusted when needed. Improperly balanced water can be corrosive and can damage pool components. Salt Generators should be monitored for adequate salt level (2700-3200 ppm) and controls checked for any error codes weekly. Scale Inhibitor should be added and pH checked and adjusted as needed. After your pool is opened you will need to monitor filter pressure. Most filters will need to be cleaned or backwashed within a week after opening. Spring Pollen and sediment are common causes for high filter pressure and cloudy water in the spring.
